## APPROPRIATE COURTROOM DRESS AND CONDUCT



**GENERAL ORDER** 

It appearing to the Court that a revised courtroom dress and conduct code should be implemented. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all persons entering the Superior Courtrooms in this circuit as 5 spectators or participants shall be properly dressed and shall conduct themselves in the following manner:

## Courtroom Dress

No one entering the courtroom shall wear jeans, shorts, or hats. No scrubs, work uniforms **GENERAL:** 

or sweatpants shall be allowed.

Long pants, dress shirts with collar and shoes are required. A belt must be worn, and MALES:

pants must be worn at the waist. No sagging or bagging pants. All shirts must be tucked

inside of pants. If a male juror, a tie, and coat are recommended.

Dresses, skirts and/or pants with blouses and shoes are required, no low-cut dresses or **FEMALES:** 

blouses or micro-length dresses, blouses or skirts shall be allowed. No skintight clothing

is allowed.

## **Courtroom Conduct**

CELL

Cell phones and any other electronic device must be turned off prior to entering the PHONES:

courtroom.

Any use of such devices in the courtroom may result in the confiscation of said device.

OTHER:

ha

No food, drink, backpacks, or large bags are allowed in the courtroom.
